# STEEL MARKET INSIGHT

Steel is a vital foundation sector establishing a base for a huge number of high-value industries such as automotive, construction, energy, aerospace and yellow goods. Over the last 12 months the industry has gone through turbulent times due to rising costs of raw materials associated with steel-making. UK steel prices jumped to multi-year highs in late June as demand recovered swiftly from a COVID-19-related slump in 2020.

#### The Industry Facing More Challenges

#### Energy


A shortage of natural gas in Europe has sent prices for electricity and gas soaring, triggering sharp rises in the prices for heating homes and operating major heavy industrial plants.

Wholesale electricity prices increased by 300% and natural gas prices by almost 400% since the end of 2020.

#### **Transport**

The transport and logistics sector has experienced significant availability constraints since the start of this year, which in turn has caused HGV salary inflation and haulier prices have risen as a result.

As part of our commitment to tackle a shortage of drivers in the UK and assist HGV drivers with advancing their careers, Guy Parker - Chairman of ParkerSteel, in partnership with TrainFor Group - Kent's Commercial Driving School, launched in September a 12 week Driver Academy training programme designed to take novice car drivers through to HGV Class 2. This scheme will ensure we are in a position to provide uninterrupted delivery of steel to our customers.



#### **Major Steel Suppliers**

As displayed in the chart below, we have seen a total increase of £520/tonne from British Steel and £493/tonne from ArcelorMittal since last summer. This has been primarily due to rising costs in raw materials and in recent months additional surcharges related to energy and transport.



#### **Our Position**

While there are undoubtedly a lot of unknowns for the future, ParkerSteel remains well positioned in the market. With secure supply chains in place domestically, within the EU and worldwide, we can adapt to all eventualities.

With our largest shipments of structural steel and plate that we received in Autumn 2021, we have kept stock levels high and have increased planned deliveries throughout the remainder of Q4 and heading into Q1 & Q2, spread across suppliers to negate any issues and allow us to be prepared for further increases in demand.

#### What It Means For Our Customers

We have secured stock to prevent as much negative impact upon our customers as possible and are encouraging all our customers to review their order book and ensure there are no availability issues that may compound over the coming months. To avoid any unexpected delays and further price rises associated with energy costs or potential tariff charges, we urge our customers to plan accordingly.


Tremendous effort has been put by our Purchasing team and Port of Dover Cargo Ltd in making this operation such a success.

In 2020, 604 high-quality bedrooms within the £139.7 million East Park project, developed by UPP for the University of Exeter, were completed with ParkerSteel Limited supplying over 300 tonnes of steel.




### HELPING RENOVATE AN NATIONAL ICON

The Elizabeth Tower (also known as Big Ben) underwent the most extensive conservation project ever carried out in the 160 years since the bell began to strike and whilst the work took place in London, teams from across the UK contributed to the restoration in one way or another, including us.

ParkerSteel Limited were delighted to work with Apex Steel Structures Ltd to prepare the temporary structures required to bring clock back to life and witness the extraordinary restoration. Our large metal plates, weighing 9 tonnes in total, were cut and drilled with precision by our experienced processing team using the Gemini, an advanced large plate processing machine.





# SOUTHERN FABRICATIONS

A unique request from our long-standing customer, to cut 16 long service awards for their employees. Our processing team achieved such an intricate design using laser technology whilst retaining an industrial look of steel to reflect their business.

### LONDON GATES & RAILINGS

ParkerSteel collaborated with London Gates & Railings Ltd to deliver 188 laser cut panels, mild steel posts and galvanised steel staircase for the new mixed-use development at 1 Olympic Way, Wembley by Sheen Lane Developments Ltd.

It was exciting to watch the unwrapping of Tower as this iconic landmark was returned to its former glory, ensuring the bells of Big Ben could be heard once more.








# MERLIN FABRICATIONS

Our FPP team expertly used CNC to supply and cut steel for this lighting gantry. Small slots were cut into stainless steel plate using our specialist water jet to provide an accurate, premier finish with defined edges that needed no further cleaning.

# THE PORT OF DOVER

We delivered 23 tonnes of steel to the Port of Dover, using our Gemini profiler cut large, 50mm thick plates into circular discs with fixing holes, profiled and milled into rings, which were to be used to repair fenders in the dock.


# THE UK'S 1ST STEEL STOCKHOLDER TO IMPROVE SAFETY WITH MID-JOURNEY FINGERPRINT DRUG TESTING

ParkerSteel Limited introduced fingerprint drug testing as part of its continual health and safety initiatives. We will use Intelligent Fingerprinting's drug screening system to encourage adherence to the company's drug safety policy by employees, including HGV drivers in charge of up to 40-tonne steel loads.

The new fingerprint drug test analyses fingertip sweat to screen for cannabis, cocaine, opiates and methamphetamine, identifying potential drug use up to 16 hours prior to the test. This is the timeframe within which illicit drug use is most likely to affect employees' fitness for duty, potentially putting themselves, their colleagues and the general public at risk. Results are available on the spot in ten minutes, with high levels of accuracy.

ParkerSteel is also making full use of the fingerprintbased system's flexibility as part of its ongoing testing regime by carrying out testing for new employee induction, random, just cause and post incident. The portable fingerprint test will replace the company's previous use of urine tests.

Commenting on the decision to opt for fingerprintbased drug screening, Andrew Stephens, Group Health & Safety Manager at ParkerSteel, said: "With our heavy steel products, we are always dealing with potentially dangerous situations. As a company we



are very safety conscious – as any accident involving the processing, manoeuvring and transport of such heavy products could be unforgiving.

With its shorter window of detection, Intelligent Fingerprinting provides us with a quick and dignified way of identifying potential employee drug misuse in the period immediately prior to their working shift.

Due to the system's portability, we can now test drivers randomly when they are in charge of steel loads of up to 40 tonnes. A key company safety requirement is that on each of our 48 HGV loaded journeys the driver pulls over into a safe place after five miles to check that chains and webbing straps are still secure, and the load is safe. We have just started to take advantage of this safety stop to carry out some random drug tests."

# DELIVERING ON OUR PROMISE TO GO GREENER

#### Making an Impact on the Environment at COP26

With the recent COP26 event in Glasgow there has been a lot of positive publicity for going green. Whilst this is a new concept for many in the steel industry, with innovation at our core, we at ParkerSteel are proud to be at the forefront of change and have been making environmentally friendly changes for a number of years now.

#### **Taking Care of Business and the Environment**

Going green doesn't mean business has to suffer. ParkerSteel Limited is looking ahead to 2022 by investing £1.75mln into enhancing our dedicated fleet of delivery vehicles. This move to strengthen our position as the most convenient steel stockholder in the UK will see the 17 British built DAF trucks delivered in 2022, adding to the 25 that have already arrived during 2021.

The DAF FTG XF and CF Tractor Units will be equipped with all the latest safety and environmental features.

Again, supporting our pledge to be a greener steel stockholder.

The new batch of trucks will be operating nationwide to service an increasing volume of steel deliveries and also provide continuous support to our customers in more isolated locations. 
He picked up a few pains along the way but that hasn't stopped him from signing up for a further 2 races next year with a 3rd potentially lined up.






